- I. Water is the most common **substance** found on earth.
- 2. Of all the earth's water, 97 percent is **salt water** in oceans and seas.
- 3. Only I percent of the earth's water is available for **drinking** water.
- 4. Sixty percent of Americans rely on lakes, rivers and streams as their source of drinking water. The other 39 percent rely on **groundwater** water located in underground aquifers and wells.
- 5. There are more than 200,000 individual **water systems** supplying water to the public in the United States.
- 6. Approximately I million miles of pipelines and **aqueducts** carry water in the United States and Canada. That's enough to circle the earth 40 times.
- 7. Seventy-five percent of a **tree** is water.
- 8. One gallon of **gasoline** can contaminate approximately 750,000 gallons of water.
- 9. It takes 1500 gallons of water to make I barrel of beer.
- 10. Each person uses about 100 gallons of water per day at home.
- II. About two-thirds of the **human body** is water. Some parts of the body contain more water than others. For example, 70 percent of your skin is water.
